Eligibility and Conditions (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Hui No`eau Visual Arts Center in association with Maui Glass Artists Association will present the second glass exhibition opening this one to statewide participation. We are challenging all artists to explore this beautiful medium even if you've never worked in glass before. We are excited about the work being done in glass in all its' forms and look forward to presenting the visitor with a unique view into the world of contemporary glass art.

****OFF ISLAND ENTRIES ONLY (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)**

Please submit jpeg(s) by February 17, 2010 to marcyl@huinoeau.com. Payment must be made at time of email entry. Juror will review on February 19, notification on February 20 via email. If selected work must arrive to the Hui by receiving day, Friday, March 5, 2010.

To make payment please call Hui No`eau and we will process over the phone. Each entry is \$10 for members and \$20 for non-members. If you wish to pay with a check, please mail with appropriate amount to Hui No`eau with a copy of entry form.

****MAUI ENTRIES**

Receiving Day is Saturday, March 6, 2010 from 10:00 am-4:00 pm. Bring piece(s) and entry forms to Hui No`eau.

The Hui and/or it's judges have the right to refuse any piece they feel does not follow the Conditions listed above.

Requirements for Eligibility:

- ◆ Entrants must be 16 years or older to participate.
- ◆ Works must be original and created with the theme in mind.
- ◆ For collaborative pieces please list all artists on label information.

Installation submissions and collaborative projects are welcome. Artists must submit a detailed sketch of the installation and PROVIDE the installation materials specific to the piece. Artist must be present to install work.

Artists may submit up to 3 entries. There is an entry fee of \$10.00 per entry for members and \$20 per entry for non-members. Due to the limitation of space in the Hui Gallery, the exhibition will typically consist of no more than 60 works. Dates for exhibition subject to change.

Extreme care will be taken in the handling and display of all work submitted to the exhibition, however, Hui No'eau is not responsible for the loss or damage of artwork and/or framing. All accepted artwork must remain in the gallery for the duration of the exhibition.

The Hui encourages artwork to be for sale during the exhibition. If artwork sells during the exhibit, commission is 50% for the artist and 50% for the Hui.

Dates to Remember

For OFF ISLAND Entries only: Online jpeg entry: deadline is Wednesday, February 17, 2010.

Online Jurying: February 19 (notification on February 20 via email)

Pieces selected through online process will need to arrive to Hui No'eau by March 5, 2010.

For Maui Entries: Receiving Day at Hui: Saturday, March 6 from 10:00 am-4:00 pm in Solarium.

Jurying and email notification: Sunday, March 7 (notification in evening)

Pickup of Non-selected work: Monday, March 8, 10:00 am – 4:00 pm

(work must be picked up on Monday, the 8th or we will need to charge a storage fee of \$10 per day)

Opening Reception: March 12, 2010 from 6:00-8:00 pm

Exhibition Dates: March 13 – April 28, 2010

Pickup of Exhibition pieces: Friday, April 29, 2010. 10:00 am – 4:00 pm.

(work must be picked up on Friday, April 29th or we will charge a storage fee of \$10 per day)
