Mele taught classes and workshops along side her tutu and mom, Paulette Nohealani Kahalepuna, and gave talks, lectures, and ran workshops for them when they were not available. Today, Mele carries on her family legacy with great pride by educating the community in traditional Hawaiian feather work including lei and kahili making.
