How Do I Enter My Students/Class?

- 1. Complete an online entry form(s) to account for each piece being entered by your students
 - a. Each form can accept up to 10 entries. If you are entering more than 10 pieces/students please complete the form again with additional entries.
- 2. Complete payment
 - a. The youth entry fee is \$5 per piece. Payment is accepted at the end of each form through credit/debit card or in-person at receiving day via check or credit/debit card. NO cash will be accepted. We recommend you pay online through the entry form to expedite the drop-off process on receiving day.
- 3. Attach artwork labels to the back upper right-hand corner of all artwork
- 4. Deliver artwork on Receiving Day:
 - a. Tuesday, August 29th / 9am-6pm / Hui No'eau Visual Arts Center

 - g. Image of artwork (under 5MB. This image will NOT be used for jurying into the exhibit and will only serve as reference for EMWP and Hui No'eau)

 - a. First & last name
 - b. Relationship to student
 - c. Phone number
- 4. Payment (\$5 per youth entry, up to 10 entries per form)
